

LSU-A Department of Education Special Education Mild/Moderate Add-On Certification Requirements

To add a mild/moderate special education endorsement to a valid Type A, B, C or Level 1, 2, 3 Louisiana certificate, you must complete 15 hours of the following course work with a grade “C” or better:

- SPED 2701 – Vocational and Transition Services for Students with Disabilities
- SPED 3701 – Assessment and Evaluation of Exceptional Learners
- SPED 3702 – Methods and Materials for Mild/Moderate Exceptional Children
- SPED 4701 – Behavioral Management of Mild/Moderate Exceptional Children
- SPED 4702 – Practicum in Assessment and Evaluation of Mild/Moderate Exceptional Learners

In addition to these 15 hours, you must pass the following PRAXIS tests:

- PRAXIS II: Education of Exceptional Students: Core Content Knowledge
(Code 20353 – Passing Score: 143)
- PRAXIS II: Education of Exceptional Students: Mild to Moderate Disabilities
(Code 10542 – Passing Score: 141)
